November 19, 2020

L Call to Order

The Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission met virtually at 2:00 p.m. on November 19, 2020. The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Nelson Morvant.

IV. Minutes

Mr. Daniel made a motion that the minutes of the October 19, 2020 be approved. Mr. Walton seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

V. Executive Director's Report

At the request of Chairman Morvant, Mr. Gary Beard gave a report on the items below. Following is a summary of items discussed at the meeting.

- Mr. Beard stated that the board must do an annual review and re-adoption of pumping limits. Mr. Walton made a motion that the current pumping limits of 25 million gallons per day for the "1,500-foot" sand and 23.5 million gallons per day for the "2,000-foot" sand be adopted for calendar year 2021. Mr. Daniel seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- Mr. Beard reported that he has requested for capital outlay for fiscal year 2021-2022.
- The draft of the District's By-Laws were reviewed and modified by members of the Board.
 Mr. Daniel made a motion to approve the By-Laws as amended and to authorize the Assistant Executive Director to correct any grammatical errors.
 Mr. Normand seconded the motion.
 A roll call vote was taken: Yays-9; Nays 0; Abstain 0.
- The draft of the District's Rules of Order were reviewed and modified by members of the Board. Mr. Walton made a motion to approve the Rules of Order as amended and to authorize the Assistant Executive Director to correct any grammatical errors. Mr. Daniel seconded the motion. A public comment was given by Russell Honore. A roll call vote was taken: Yays – 10; Nays – 0; Abstain – 0.
- Mr. Beard presented the amended budget for fiscal year 2020-2021. The total expenditures remain the same, Mr. Walton made a motion to approve the budget. Mr. Normand seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mr. Beard reported that there will be a virtual kickoff meeting for Phase 2 of the Capital Area Groundwater Conservation Commission Strategic Plan.
